APPLICATION FOR HIGH SCHOOL CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT

ADMISSION CRITERIA

Students attending accredited high schools, unaccredited high schools or are home schooled must meet the following criteria for concurrent enrollment admission:

- Students must be juniors or seniors and eligible to graduate from high school in the spring of their senior year. Students who are home schooled or attending an unaccredited high school must be at least 16 years of age as a junior and 17 years of age as a senior.
- Students must participate in the American College Testing program (ACT) or the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT).
- <u>SAT is for Admission purposes only, not course placement.</u>
- Juniors must have a composite score of 21 (ACT) or 980 (SAT) or cumulative un-weighted high school GPA of 3.5. Seniors must have a composite score of 19 (ACT) or 900 (SAT) or cumulative un-weighted high school GPA of 3.0.
- Students who opt to take TCC's residual ACT test will only be allowed to use the first test taken during the year for admission and placement purposes. (For testing purposes, the year starts Nov. 1st and ends the following Oct. 31st). Students who take the National ACT Exam can repeat the test without consequence.

Student must provide the following credentials to the Enrollment Services Office on the campus of attendance:

- Tulsa Community College Online Application for Admission
- Concurrent Enrollment Application with appropriate signatures
- A current official high school transcript is required each academic year
- Official ACT or SAT scores (ACT scores required for course placement)

Admission to the institution does not guarantee eligibility for course placement.

ACE Tuition Waiver Scholarship is awarded on a "<u>First come-first served basis</u>" as funds are available. Students must be enrolled in a minimum of three (3) and a maximum of six (6) credit hours per semester and must follow the policy regulations.

ENROLLMENT CRITERIA

Students attending accredited high schools, unaccredited high schools or are home schooled must meet the following criteria for enrollment in classes:

- Both juniors and seniors must be proficient in the area in which they wish to enroll.
 - Students must have a 19 (ACT) subject score in English, Mathematics, and/or Science Reasoning to enroll in those courses. Tulsa Community College requires that a student score a 20 (ACT) in Math to enroll in MATH 1513 (College Algebra).
 - Additionally, students must have a 19 (ACT) in Reading to enroll in any other collegiate course. TCC's Computerized Placement Test (COMPASS) may not be used to meet the proficiency requirements.
- Enrollment for all concurrent students will not exceed 19 credit hours per long semester or 9 credit hours for summer. For purposes of calculating workload, one-half high school unit shall be equivalent to three semester hours of college work.
- Zero Level Courses (intended for remediation of curricular or performance deficiency) and Physical Education Activity courses are not eligible for concurrent enrollment.
- Concurrently Enrolled High School Students may not audit college courses.
- Re-enrollment is contingent upon the student achieving a college overall GPA of 2.0 or higher in TCC classes.
- All other students not qualified by grade level may be considered for enrollment under the <u>Opportunity Admissions</u> category.
