<b>Course Description</b>	<p>University transfer, 1000 level, general education courses. A TCC user number or T# will be assigned and students can access their MyTCC account with this number.	<p>Tuition: *ACE Waiver (applicable for up to 6 credit hours per semester. See Restriction for Waiver below).</p> <p>Tuition: Approximately \$290.00 per three credit hour course if *ACE Waiver is unavailable.</p> <p>Fees: \$36.75 per three hour credit course. \$73.50 for 2 - three credit hour courses.</p> <p>*See Restrictions for Waiver below **Additional course specific fees may be assessed and will vary per course. <b>Enrollment Instructions:</b>	Students taking courses at any TCC community campus or partner campus location will work through their high school counselor's office to complete the enrollment form. The student will present the enrollment form, high school transcript, and ACT scores to enrollment services at any TCC campus.

	Student will make all payments at the campus bursar office. Make sure to identify yourself as concurrent enrollment student so as to receive the tuition waiver.
<b>TCC Admission Criteria:</b> This is actual admittance into TCC. This criteria is separate from the criteria needed to enroll in specific courses. (See Below).	<b>Juniors:</b> ACT Composite Score of 21 or above <b>or</b> 3.5 GPA <b>Seniors:</b> ACT Composite Score of 19 or above <b>or</b> 3.0 GPA  College admission does not guarantee course placement.
<b>TCC Enrollment Criteria ACT Subject Scores and / or Pre-requisites.</b>  Students check with high school and college advisors to assess what each course will count as on HS or College transcript.	Criteria for enrollment in classes on campuses will be based on the appropriate ACT subject scores.  <b>Science Reasoning 19:</b> -Eligible for any Science Course <b>Math 20:</b> Eligible for any Math course <b>English 19:</b> Eligible for any English course <b>Reading 19:</b> Eligible for any other collegiate course
<b>Academic Calendar:</b> Since concurrent means a student is enrolled in both high school and college at the same time, the student must check both calendars to know what days they are expected to be in class and/or doing online work.	All courses follow the TCC academic calendar and finals schedule. If your high school is not in session, the student is still expected to attend their college courses if TCC is in session. Always check with your instructor and on Blackboard for course information.
<b>Finals Schedule</b>	Follows TCC Finals Exam Schedule.
<b>Books</b>	Students provide their books. The cost depends on each course. Books can be purchased at TCC bookstore at the campus where they will attend.
<b>***University Transfer</b>	See a TCC advisor and contact the receiving university to make sure of the transferability of a particular course. Check with your high school advisor also to make sure how a course is counted towards your high school transcript.

\*ACE Tuition Waiver – This is a concurrent enrollment waiver and has a maximum of six credit hours per semester (including summer). See Counselors' Corner for details.

\*\*Course Specific Fees can be applied and will vary from course to course.
